Between December of 2021 through December 2022 the Enthronement Guild sadly had many losses of key people who helped to create and maintain the Guild of today. Sr. Romaine Krug, IHM, one of the founding members of the Diocesan Enthronement Guild of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary passed away at 109 years of age on November 18, 2022, and was the oldest living member of the IHM Congregation at the time. Sister Romaine assisted in the establishment of the Enthronement Guild in 1945 and served as Moderator of the Guild from 1960 to 1990. She also served as Treasurer for many years. Sister Romaine was such a wonderful tribute to the Two Hearts, and a blessing to us all. She is looking down on us from heaven and praying for our successful activities on behalf of the Hearts of Jesus and Mary. Thank you, Sr. Romaine, for your prayers and guidance on our behalf.

Sr. Barbara Nogiewich, IHM passed away on December 18 of 2021 after a long illness. Sister was a Board member and provided assistance with mailings and other tasks of the Guild. She will be remembered for her smiling presence and willingness to help whenever help was needed. Her presence among us is deeply missed, yet we know she is watching over our endeavors and assisting with prayer.

Jane O'Neill served as Treasurer of the Guild until her death on April 19, 2022. Jane was a member of the IHM Religious Order for 15 years until she left in 1987 to pursue a career in business, ultimately working as an Executive for Fannie Mae in Washington, D.C. She retired from Fannie Mae in 2007 and returned to Scranton to work for the IHM director of associates Congregation as overseeing lay ministries among nuns on the East Coast. She retired in 2021 due to health reasons. Jane loved being a part of the Enthronement Guild and always held a positive attitude on life and spiritual activity. We miss her gentle guidance and wisdom.

Chester Montante passed away on February 16, 2022, and served as a Board member of the Guild along with his wife Maria for many years. Chet was 104 years of age when he passed. He had a wonderful sense of humor and loved to give away Sacred Heart pins to people to remind them of the blessings of the Sacred Heart. Chet was truly an emissary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and will be remembered for his strong faith and jovial nature. He always lifted the atmosphere at Enthronement Guild meetings.
