Feast of the Sacred Heart Annual Mass and Dinner Held at the IHM Center on June 7th

The Sacred Heart Enthronement Guild gathered at the IHM Center on the evening of June 7th for the celebration of the Eucharist in honor of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. Rev Pio Mandato, F.M.H.J. was the main celebrant and homilist. Father Joseph Sibilano, OSJ and Father Lee Havey, CP concelebrated.

The celebration began with a musical prelude by the Sacred Heart Singers under the direction of Ernie Pappa and Jennifer Michel joined by Maryanne DeMark on piano and Lenny Longo on Drums.

Following the Eucharistic liturgy, dinner was served in the Theresa Maxis Conference Center. The dinner program included the crowning of the statues of Jesus and Mary by Sister Romaine Krug, IHM, and Sister Patricia Hauser, IHM, on the occasion of their 75th and 50th Jubilees. More than 150 Guild members and their guests attended the Dinner. Stephen Englot, President of the Guild, and Patrick Williams, Vice President, served as the toastmasters. Ernie Pappa, Director of Communications and Rev. Joseph Sibilano, OSJ, offered remarks.



The Enthronement of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary was established at Marywood College in 1945 by Bishop William Hafey. Father Edward Collins served as the first diocesan director and Sister Ethelbert Gilroy, IHM, was the first moderator. Sister Romaine Krug, IHM succeeded Sister Ethelbert. Sister Celesta Sinisi, IHM succeeded Sister Romaine and served as moderator for 20 years. Maria Pappa has served as the Coordinator for the past four years.
